Chapter “D” Richmond, Virginia July 1984 – July 2008 24 Year Anniversary Celebration

A small group of interested Gold Wing owners met at Earl and Cathy Banton's house in the summer of 1984 to start what was to become the 4th Gold Wing Road Riders Association Chapter in Virginia. Their first meeting was held on Sunday, July 15, 1984 at 3:00 pm with a pot luck supper for the 12 new "CHARTER MEMBERS" of "Chapter D". One year later in July 1985 the Chapter had grown to 58 members. The Chapter "D" staff was organized in 1985.

The new Chapter "D" was organized by Earl & Cathy Banton, with Earl being it's first "Area Representative". Others followed to lead Chapter D including:

First Chapter Queen & VA State Queen - 1984 - Margaret Burkett.

First Bike Show - March 1985, Blue Knights Motorcycle Expo, Richmond Arena.

First Parade - October 5, 1985, at the West Point Crab Festival & Parade.

First Ride on the Track at South Boston Speedway - June 1987 before the race.

First Halloween Party - October 1988 at the home of Bob & Carol Witherspoon.

First Taste of Bike Week - March 1988 some Chapter members visit Daytona for sun, sand, cycles and scantily clad women.

First Virginia State Couple - October 1988 Jane and Vernon Vanderloecht became the first State Couple for Virginia.

First Wingless Weekend - January 1989, Kings Quarters at Kings Dominion.

First Poker Run - August 1990, at Cycle Connection of Virginia to benefit MDA.

First Rivah Rally & Fish Fry – Summer 1997 at Jamaica, VA

In September 1987 Earl Banton resigned as Area Representative of Chapter D and took on a new position as Virginia State Director, which he held until December 1992.

Chapter "D" is the home of the last "Wing Ding Queen", Cathy Banton who started as Chapter Queen, rose to level of State Queen at the Virginia State Rally, then went on to the Region as Region "B" Queen and competed and won at the top level as Wing Ding Queen at Wing Ding in Knoxville, Tennessee in August 1985. Chapter Couples competition started in 1986. Our first Chapter Couple, Jane & Vernon Vanderloecht went on to win the title of Virginia State Couple in 1987. A couple is selected each year to represent Chapter "D" at the Virginia District Rally and they compete for the title of Virginia District Couple. Before January 1995, GWRRA had 9 Regions in the USA and 3 Regions in Canada. After January 1, 1995, the USA now has 13 Regions and maintains the Regions in Canada. Virginia, which had previously been in Region B is now a member of the newly created Region N family along with West Virginia, Kentucky, Tennessee, and North Carolina.

Chapter "D" has always been a group that enjoys a good time whether it's riding the highways or gathering for the annual Christmas party. The annual Christmas parties have always been extra special and are attended by members of Chapters from around the state. After the group had outgrown the "homes of its members" it was decided that we needed a facility large enough to accommodate everyone who wanted to share in a little Christmas cheer. Our first Christmas Party away from "home" was at the North Chamberlayne Recreation Center in Northside and we had a pot luck supper, music and dancing. The succeeding years brought even bigger and better parties to include the Belly Dancers in 1987, the Womanless Wedding in 1988 and the Holly Follies Dance Revue in 1989. And who can forget the annual visit from that jolly ol' elf himself, Santa along with his Missus, who help distribute Christmas gifts to all.

2003 & ongoing – In the 2003 Richmond Ride for Kids charity ride, Chapter D & its members were the 4th largest group in raising funds. Cycle Connection was the largest business fundraiser and Chris and Kathy Hooper were the number one individual fundraisers for 2004. What a great team we have!
